The School expects parents of students to be actively involved in the student's education. In order for our faculty and staff to effectively educate our children, we welcome our parents as partners. Parents are strongly encouraged to participate in a variety of activities and forums that will support our students academically and add to the vitality of our school.

A parent conference is a formally scheduled conversation between faculty and parents in order to discuss the student's development and progress. Parents will be required to confer with faculty about their child's/children's social and academic achievement on a regular basis as scheduled by the School. As well, the School encourages parents to initiate conferences about their questions and concerns with the Instruction Coordinator and/or network Regional Director.

In furtherance of the information above, the School shall ascertain and make notation on each enrollment application the parent's/guardian's language proficiency (i.e, spoken and reading capacity) in both the English and Spanish languages in order to determine in which language (written as well as verbal) communication will be most effective to be used with each parent/guardian. Likewise, the School shall, at time of enrollment, ascertain the "internet access" at the home of each family and note it on the enrollment application form.
